## USC Football Announces 19-Player Signing Class

Three players already enrolled at the university.

February 3, 2010

LOS ANGELES - Fifteen high school football players and one junior college player signed letters of intent with USC, new Trojan head coach Lane Kiffin announced today.

Additionally, RB Dillon Baxter of Mission Bay HS in San Diego, Calif., DB Patrick Hall of St. Bonaventure HS in Ventura, Calif., and WR Kyle Prater of Proviso West HS in Hillside, Ill., already enrolled at USC in January as freshmen and will participate in the upcoming spring practice. Hall originally signed with USC in 2009, but did not qualify for admission.

Kiffin noted that several other signings could be announced soon.
